**Subject:** To Be Considered a Race Starter

## Introduction

The following clarification of existing ASN Canada FIA regulations will be effective as of Race #9 of the 2006 NCKC Championship Series:

### 1. To Be Considered a Race Starter

ASN Canada FIA 2006 Canadian Karting Regulations Book 1 Section 10.6 "To Be Considered a Race Starter" states that:

- a) To be considered a race starter, a qualified kart/driver must enter the race before the field has completed 1 green flag lap. Karts that do not comply with this Regulation shall be classified as "DNS".
- b) A driver that has qualified for a starting position, but does not start the scheduled race shall not receive any qualifying or racing points.

For the NCKC Championship Races, the phrase "enter the race" will be taken to mean "receive the green flag". In effect, any driver that fails to cross the starting line and take the green flag before being lapped by the rest of the field will be classified as DNS and receive 0 points for the session in question.

Additionally, as the Qualifying, Pre-Final, and Final sessions at NCKC events are all scored independently, points scored by a DNS driver in non-DNS sessions will be valid despite part b) above.
