Safety First

We are very proud of our safety record! Our races are sanctioned by ASN Canada and we follow a strict set of Kart Safety and Racing Regulations. All novice and junior races are also overseen by participating parents. Race meets are fully insured and attended by ambulance staff.

Championship Season

NCKC runs a 10 event championship with races typically on Sundays starting in May and running into September.

Many racers arrive on the Saturday for practice and tuning, camping overnight to enjoy the company of fellow racers, a potluck dinner or movie night.

Race Days run rain or shine and consist of 4 lapping sessions for each race class.

Practise, Qualification, Prefinal and Final Races typically start early in the morning and wrap up mid afternoon with an awards celebration providing trophies to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each class.

At the end of every season we hold the hugely popular NCKC Enduro, designed specifically to let new racers take part in a race by sharing a members kart in a fun event.

And just before the snow flies we have our Awards Banquet to celebrate our class winners and have fun with other club members.
