

NCKC Request For Proposal - 2008

Tire Purchase Agreement



Background

NCKC operates as a non-profit karting club in Ottawa. There are 100+ members. 150 sets of Bridgestone were purchased by members in 2007.

Local dealers currently supply members with tires- spec rain and spec dry. Our current contract has ended- NCKC received a rebate per kart entry per race in 2006 and 2007.

Tire Spec – please indicate the exact specifications for your proposed Dry and Wet tire(s) for 4 stroke and Rotax.

NCKC Classes in 2007 – same are expected in 2008

4 stroke - Honda 5.5 (GT 160) and 6.5 (GT 200) - 6 classes (3 junior, 3 senior)
2 Stroke - Rotax - 1 Senior class (Senior and Masters)

Average participation on race days in 2007 – 61 drivers

NCKC Preferred Conditions – please address each point

1. Term - not to exceed 2 years.
2. NCKC will use a dealer network - members buy from dealers.
3. Supplier must state a "best customer" price policy for NCKC.
4. NCKC may hold "open tire" events if necessary -at no disadvantage (eg OKCC race counts)
5. NCKC may hold first 2 races to burn off previous brand if necessary at no disadvantage
6. Rebates must be paid by the fall AGM date (mid- November)
7. NCKC is not bound by a minimum number of purchases
8. NCKC will attempt to restrict "off-shore" purchases, but cannot guarantee it.
9. Dealer may brand tires at their cost.
10. Tires must be of consistent type and quality for the entire contract period.
11. Supplier must have a local sales outlet or representative within 40 km of Parliament Hill.
12. Please indicate your rebate policy, conditions and details.
